Our projects in Toulouse on the former Latécoère industrial site, as urban planners and architects, with all the impetus given by our client Icade, are part of a long-term project, with the essential challenge of bringing living back to the heart of a new habitat!

Before delivery, we are delighted to announce that our CYMEA residence [lot 1B] has won the #biodiversity prize in the #Toulouseplusverte challenge.

To achieve this, teamwork is essential, and BIOCENYS, with Emmanuelle Parache, was instrumental in helping the project owner to obtain the label:

- «... . 48% of surface area de-waterproofing of which 38% open ground
- . A Biodiversity label with a BBAC label
- . a 3-year program of nature-related activities for residents
- . 950m<sup>2</sup> of green facades and over 4000m<sup>2</sup> of meadows, hedges, copses and trees
- . wildlife habitats and an educational trail ...»
